Detectives Arrest Man in November Home Invasion

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Office Special Investigation detectives arrested a 50-year-old man Thursday evening in connection with the November home invasion and theft at a St. Charles Mesa home.

William Gonzales was arrested on a warrant for aggravated robbery, first-degree kidnapping, first-degree burglary, criminal mischief and theft. He was booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

A warrant for Gonzales' arrest was issued in late November after he was identified as one of the suspects who forced their way into a home on Daniel Road on November 8, tied up a resident and stole several items including vehicles, guns and assorted tools. The victim was not injured in the incident.

Deputies responded to the residence in the 30000 block of Daniel Road after the victim called to report at least four men forced their way into a camper he was staying in on the property. The man said the suspects pointed a gun at him, tied him up with a cord and forced him to open the door of a nearby garage.

Once inside the garage, the suspects ransacked the building and left with thousands of dollars in tools, several guns, a 2005 Dodge 1500 truck and a 2016 Nissan Frontier truck. The damages and loss of property were estimated at nearly \$100,000.

Sheriff's detectives have located and recovered both stolen vehicles. More arrests could be forthcoming.

No additional information will be released at this time due to this being an ongoing investigation.
