Man Arrested for Breaking into Pueblo West Library, Causing Extensive Damage

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies arrested a 21-year-old man this morning on felony charges after discovering he broke into the Pueblo West Library and caused thousands of dollars in damage.

A deputy responded to the library at 298 E. Joe Martinez Blvd., at about 8:15 a.m. today, on a report that a window to the building had been broken. When deputies arrived, they found the front window shattered and several rocks lying inside the building.

Library personnel were contacted and asked to respond to give deputies access to the building so a thorough search could be completed to ensure no one was inside. As deputies were waiting for the employee to arrive, they saw a man identified as Boden White inside the building. Deputies detained White, who admitted to breaking into the building.

After gaining access to the library from an employee, deputies searched the building and discovered significant damage to several computers, office equipment, and machines. White also admitted to deputies that he broke the equipment. The estimated damage to the library and equipment is more than \$10,000.

White was arrested for second-degree burglary, criminal mischief and second-degree trespassing. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

“Our deputies responded immediately to the call and their quick actions led to the safe arrest of the suspect, who was still inside the building,” said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. “Their professionalism and readiness reflect the high standard of service our community expects, and I’m proud of the work they do every day to keep Pueblo County safe.”
