Sheriff's Office Seeking Information on Missing Pueblo West Teenager

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is seeking help in locating a 15-year-old Pueblo West girl, who was reported as a runaway by her family on January 27.

Jewelieanna Muniz left the family home in the 900 block of S. Honeysuckle Drive in Pueblo West. A family member reported he went to wake up Jewelieanna for school the morning of January 27 and discovered she was not in her room. A window in her room was open. Jewelieanna could be staying with people in Pueblo, Colorado Springs or Denver.

Pueblo County Sheriff's Detectives have been actively searching for Jewelieanna and believe her welfare is endangered due to her age.

Jewelieanna is described as 5-foot-5, 190 pounds with long dark brown hair and hazel eyes. She was last reported wearing gray sweatpants, a black T-shirt, black hoodie and black tennis shoes with a gold stripe.
