Sheriff's Office Seeks Help in Identifying Armed Robbery Suspect

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is seeking assistance in identifying a suspect in an armed robbery of a Pueblo West liquor store late Sunday night.

Deputies responded to Cheers Liquor, 316 S. McCulloch Blvd. at about 9:45 p.m. on a report of an armed robbery. Witnesses told deputies a man walked into the store and came up to the counter brandished a handgun and threatened an employee. The suspect took an undisclosed amount of money from the register and left the store on foot going southwest.

The man is described as African American about 6-foot-4 and about 170 to 180 pounds. He was wearing black beanie, black pants, a black jacket and black tennis shoes.

The suspect may still be in the Pueblo West area. If you see him, notify the Sheriff's Office immediately. Please use caution as he is armed with a handgun.
